Bunnyrabbit Program (children 5 years of age and younger)

The **Bunnyrabbit Program** is the first level of the Active Start stage of development. Program materials include an enrolment kit, a kid-friendly, age-appropriate booklet and skill award stickers. The objective of the program is to introduce cross-country skiing and the healthy lifestyle associated with it through organized activity and active play.

Jackrabbit Program (children 6-9 years of age)

The **Jackrabbit Program** is designed for the “**FUNDamentals**” stage of development. Program materials include an enrolment kit, an age appropriate booklet that provides a comprehensive record of the young skier’s ski career and “technique” and “program” award stickers to chart the different levels of achievement. The objective is for children to learn basic cross-country ski skills (both classic and skating) and to instill a lifelong interest in the sport, thereby enhancing their quality of life and health.

Track Attack Program (skiers 10-12 years of age)

The **Track Attack Program** is designed for skiers in the '**Learning to Train**' stage of development. Program materials include a program-specific enrolment kit, an age appropriate booklet and coaching materials specific to this stage in the skier development progression. The objective is for the participants to become technically competent cross-country skiers and to utilize those skills to explore a wide range of cross-country ski activities, from backcountry excursions to ski tournaments.
